## BOARDING POLICY

- All dogs must have current immunizations against Rabies, Distemper, Parvo Virus, and Bordetella..
- All cats must have current immunizations against Rabies, Feline Distemper, Rhinotracheitis, Calici Virus, and Feline Leukemia.
- All animals must have had a Fecal Examination for internal parasites or have been de-wormed within the last 12 months.
- All animals must be free of external parasites (fleas & ticks) when admitted for boarding; or must be treated upon admission.
- All clients are required to read and sign the boarding admitting form.
- Animals will be admitted & discharged during regular office hours and from 6pm to 7pm on Saturdays, Sundays and most holidays.
- Any animal that requires emergency or immediate veterinary attention will receive it at our discretion, and at the owner's expense.
- Emergency contact information should be left with the clinic.
- Animals requiring medication or treatment (such as wound treatment) will be charged appropriate fees.
- Please inform us if you have any questions or concerns pertaining to the care of your pet. Your satisfaction and you pet's well-being are our primary concerns.
- Be aware that your pet's diet may have varied while away from home. They may have barked at other animals; or the temperature & humidity may have been slightly different from your home. This can create problems such as sore throats, tonsillitis, or diarrhea. We seek to prevent such problems, but you must understand that these problems do develop. Owners will be charged appropriate fees for all treatment and medication needed for reasons that are not directly under our control.
- If you wish to furnish your own food, please bring enough for your dogs stay in a sealed container. If you wish us to provide food, we will feed Science Diet Sensitive Skin/Stomach.
